AMATEUR/SENIOR/HANDICAP

Three tournaments played together over 2 days at 2 terrific courses: Arbutus Ridge and Victoria Golf Clubs. June 2 and June 3.

Amateur:

First played in 1920, and the Champion and Runner-up represent Zone 5 at BC Amateur Championship. Stroke Play; Open to all Zone 5 Women with a Handicap Factor of 18.1 or lower.

Senior:

First played in 1981, and the Champion and Runner-up represent Zone 5 at BC Senior Championship. Stroke Play; Open to all Zone 5 Women with a Handicap Factor of 18.1 or lower, who are 50 years or older.

Note: For people who qualify for both Amateur and Senior, you may enter both and your rounds will count for both competitions.

Handicap:

This one brings handicaps into play and is open to all Zone 5 Women with a verifiable handicap factor. Stroke Play.

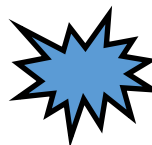
